



Regulations for District Chess Associations

1. All District Chess Associations have to pay an **annual Affiliation fee** at the beginning of each financial year i.e. within 10th of April, to Bengal Chess Association.
2. All District Chess Associations are required to conduct **District Chess Championship** every year for selection of players for State Championships.
3. District Chess Associations are required to **submit the full list of committee members** along with their contact details to Bengal Chess Association.
4. **No District Association shall have more than 20% members from one family or relatives.**
5. All the affiliated district associations should be dedicated, concentrated and focused only in activities related to promotion, development and spreading awareness of chess.
6. The District Chess Associations are required to **affiliate all Clubs/Academies** in their Districts. All the Clubs/Academies which are affiliated are required to furnish their list of members and details of chess coaches, if any.
7. The District Associations shall help to **distribute the official periodicals** of BCA through the clubs and other affiliates.

8. **7. All correspondence** seeking permission/affiliations must be responded to by latest **one week** from the receipt of such communications.
9. The Districts have to submit their annual **Audited Statement of Accounts** to BCA within **3 months** of year end.
10. Districts have to ensure that **membership base** increases each year. Districts have also to ensure that membership Registration fees are collected from individuals as per rules and regulations laid down by BCA separately.
11. The District Chess Associations have to promote state level **arbiters** and **coaches** and by encouraging them to attend State level seminars and other related programmes. It is mandatory for each District to have at least one State Arbiter.
12. District Chess Associations are required to cooperate with BCA with regard to **“Chess in Schools”** project for furthering spread of chess in districts.
